



STORM DAMAGE GUIDE

Central Texas sees its fair share of severe weather each year with strong thunderstorms, wind-driven rain, hail and even tornadoes. If, after a storm, you suspect you might have damage to your roof, the first thing to do is to call a contractor you trust. Do not attempt to climb onto your roof as the structure could be weakened or the shingles could be damaged and possibly slick.



The following conditions can be checked from the ground and may indicate that your roof has sustained damage:

- ★ Do you see dents or damage to the gutters, siding or screens on your home?
- ★ Look around the yard and property. Are tree limbs on the ground? Can you see twigs or other debris on the roof? Are there shingle pieces in the yard?
- ★ Do vehicles have visible hail dents?
- ★ Do you see water stains on the ceilings inside your home?

Remember that not all damage will be visible from the ground which is why it's important to have a professional contractor perform a thorough examination of your roof.
